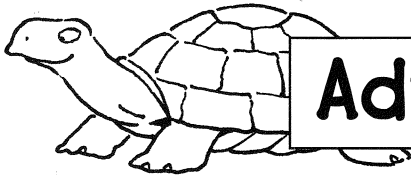
Story Pyramid
