## What is a resume?

A resume is a <u>marketing tool</u> to promote yourself and get an interview.

A resume shows that you are a match for a position.

A resume is a summary of...

- Education
- Experience
- Skills

## How is a resume used?

A resume can be used when applying for an internship, graduate course, volunteering, or an employment opportunity. (Know your audience!)

Resume -> Interview -> (References) -> Offer

Did you know? Employers initially spend about 30 seconds or less looking at each resume.

- Make a good impression, quickly!

## Know your audience!

Match the content with the resume with the position.

Volunteering to teach children = Focus on your experience with children

Teaching adults = Focus on your experience teaching high school students and above

Educational publisher = Focus on your experience of developing lesson plans and materials

## **Resume design: The basics**

1~2 pages

Use a standard font (Arial, Helvetica)

Use **bolding**, <u>underlining</u>, *italics*, CAPS, etc.

Use lines and boxes to separate sections/headings

Use bullet points with action verbs

Balance white space and text

Check spelling x 1,000

Save and send as a PDF

Save as Name\_resume.pdf -> EdwardPovey\_resume

Content (some of these are flexible - vital sections in red):

- Photo (Korea only not needed abroad)
- Contact information
- Objectives
- Education (courses and certificates)
- Teaching experience
- Work experience
- Volunteering / Leadership experience
- Honors / Awards
- Interests
- References

# This is the second page of my older resume (2008).

Notice how the teaching and 'other' work experience are separate sections.

This is because I didn't have a lot of teaching experience, so I wanted to highlight that first.

The experience in the 'other' section is only what I think is relevant.

Tip: If you don't have a lot of experience, use the 'Enter' button more often!

## **Resume: Main sections**

## Contact information

Be easy to contact Don't use a strange email address: sexy872@naver.com

## Education

Give more detail for your recent and relevant education. e.g. TESOL Cert -> list the courses, your coursework

## Work experience // Teaching experience

Give more detail for your recent and relevant work. Delete older work that isn't relevant.

### References

Check the description of the position requirements. Often one work and one educational reference needed.

# Resume language: action verbs

Use action verbs to give details about your work and education. For example:

- Developed English materials for business English students
- <u>Created</u> teaching materials such as board games and worksheets using compete software
- <u>Demonstrated</u> my teaching skills using detailed lessons plans I had developed
- Led a group of students in creating a literacy word wall based on the story "The Hungry Caterpillar"
- <u>Produced</u> a poster based on "Task-Based Language Teaching" techniques

Writing tips: Remember the three C's

# Clarity

make presentation clear and concise

# Consistency

do not mix categories, dates, and design features

# Conciseness

summarize and highlight

## Writing tips: How do I choose what will go in the final draft?

- What is most relevant for the job?
- Which aspects are more recent?
- What makes me special and unique?
- What are the important duties, tasks and achievements I completed?
- What might interest the potential employer?
- Which categories do I need? (volunteering, teaching experience...)
