What is **TESOL**

- Teaching of English to Speakers of Other Languages
- It involves 2 key elements:

Teaching English (Language)



- 1. Make a definition of **teaching** that expresses everything you think that teaching involves
- 2. Make a definition of language
- 3. Make a list of the challenges that you think are involved in the **teaching of English or any foreign language**

Teaching

- Provide input and opportunities for output
- At an appropriate level
- In a safe classroom environment
- Generate interest and motivation
- Use many diverse activities
- Provide clear instructions
- Use consistent classroom management
- Provide error correction
- Use assessment
- Help learners be aware of the target culture

Language

- Universal
- Communication
- Culture
- Complex
 - Grammar
 - Vocabulary
 - 4 skills, etc..
